Celia is a Member of Council for Church in Communities (CIC), an international apostolic oversight and accountability network based in the United Kingdom. Celia also works as a consultant to civic and community development agencies in the UK. She has recently been appointed as a Vice President at Tearfund, an international aid agency in the UK.

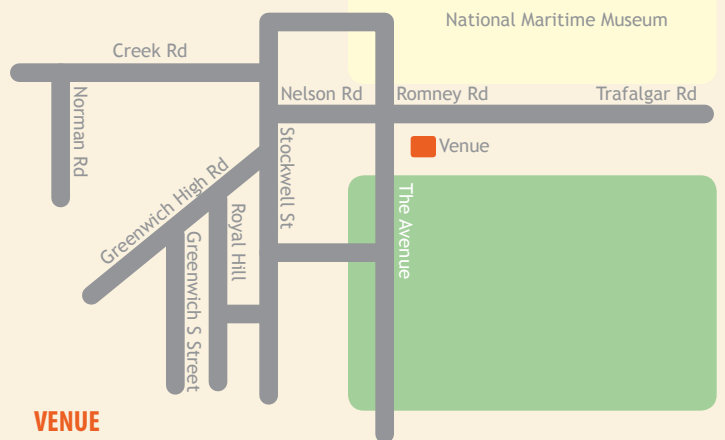
WHO MUST ATTEND?
